Description: A medium-sized, perennial woody shrub, growing to a height of 200 - 300 cm. It is many branched, dense and extremely prickly, making it almost impenetrable. Leaves are dark green and glossy on the upperside, pale green and slightly woolly on the underside. Leaf margins are deeply dentate with sharp spines. The inflorescence is a large, showy composite head of brilliant yellow ray and disc flowers.

When flowering, it is very conspicuous, adding splashes of bright yellow to a rocky landscape.

Habitat: Berkheya chamaepeuce grows amongst rocks in mountainous areas of NamibRand, it is particularly abundant on the south facing slopes of Gorrasis mountains. It occurs in Namibia and the Northern Cape.
