Description: A small shrub, sometimes low and spreading. Leaves simple and elliptical with margins entire. Oppositely arranged on branches, light green in colour and covered with very small prickles which also occur on the stem. The flowers are small with bright red and yellow petals. Flowers grow in a dense cluster sometimes forming a ball.

Habitat: *P. setosum* grows on course sand and gravel, and is common in many of the plains and dry riverbeds of the reserve. It does not occur in the dunes.
